


Home Use of the Amsler Grid

- 1. Perform the examination at reading distance, wearing your reading glasses and using good light.
- 2. Cover one eye and look directly at the center dot in the grid.
- 3. Look only at the center dot. Using your side vision, check for any irregularities, wavy lines, cloudy areas, or blind spots on the grid.
- 4. Cover the other eye and repeat the test with the second eye—waiting several seconds to be sure the eye is clear.
- If you notice any *CHANGES* in the grid that were not present before, telephone within 48 hours to report your symptoms and arrange a priority appointment.



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
